Opening Ceremony – Survivor & Caregiver Laps!

We welcome the community to Relay by having our Survivors lead the first lap- they are the reason we are here and we want to celebrate with them their victory against cancer. Survivors are greeted at the end of their lap by Novato Police Officers and Firefighters who will present them with medals. They are joined for the next lap by their caregivers to recognize those who have helped them through their journey.

Fundraising & Entertainment

The track is lined with Relay teams who have set up “campsite” areas for fundraising and fun activities all day. Throughout the event, there will be plenty of food, games, contests, music and fun to participate in, all while raising money to fund cancer research, treatment prevention and programs



Luminaria Ceremony (To Honor & Remember) – Silent Lap

The Luminaria ceremony is a time for us to reflect on why we are here, and why we must continue to fight against this horrible disease. We have a silent lap of reflection, lit only by the luminaria bags representing those affected by cancer, to remember those who have passed away and to honor those still in the fight and those who have won their battle

Camping Out & Walking

Many people choose to stay at Relay overnight (although this is not required), making new friends and memories, sharing stories and walking the track all night long. We invite the community to walk with us and enjoy the energy of a community working together for the common goal of wiping out cancer.



Relay for Life is a community event to raise money for the American Cancer Society. Team members take turns walking the track. Funds raised go towards research, and providing services to cancer patients. These services include a 24 hour 800 number manned by real people to provide patients and caregivers with information on treatment options, rides to and from treatments, low or no cost lodging when travel to treatments is necessary, wigs, and information on support groups.
